# SCHOLARSHIPS FOR SCHOLARS...

- Nonprofit organization dedicated to recognizing and rewarding academic excellence through merit-based scholarships for graduating Anne Arundel County high school students.
- Founded in 1984 by AACPS Superintendent Dr. Edward J. Anderson.
- Since inception, more than \$4 million has been awarded to over 1,000 county high school seniors.
- Last year 34 scholarships totaling \$196,000 were awarded.



# ELIGIBILITY

- Open to graduating high school seniors who are AAC residents attending public or private schools in AAC, as well as home-schooled students.
- Minimum weighted GPA required: either 3.75 or 3.5, depending on the scholarship.
- Awards are merit based and granted without regard to financial need.

All eligible scholarship applications are automatically considered for the following honorary awards:


- Edward J. Anderson Scholarship- \$9,000

# TIMELINE 2025 - 2026

- October 15: Applications available
- February 3: Student portion deadline
- February 10: Transcript and letters of recommendation deadline
- April 2: Decisions announced
- April 29: Awards ceremony
